



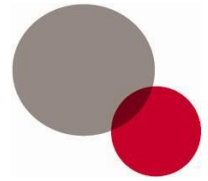

IELTS is recognised as the standard test for students wishing to enter university or demonstrate their level of competence for employment. (If you require your IELTS for UK visa purposes please check with the UKVI which test centres you are permitted to attend before you book your test.)

The fee for Eastbourne tests in 2020 is **£180** (pounds sterling). You may pay by one of these methods:

- **Credit card** – Visa, MasterCard, Solo or Electron only: please phone the office between 9am and 12.30pm Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday to make payment AFTER you have completed the online application. The office is closed on Thursdays.
- **Cheque** – make payable to: **East Sussex College**.
- **Postal orders** – buy them from a UK Post Office and make payable to: **East Sussex College** before you send them.
- **Cash** – In person between 9am and 12.30pm Monday Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday.

Your IELTS results will be sent to you by means of a Test Report Form, 13 calendar days after the test. We are not allowed to give results by telephone, fax or e-mail. If you need us to send additional copies to a university or other authority to which you are applying, a charge will be made for this if it is not done at application. You may ask for copies to be sent direct to a university up to two years after your IELTS test.
